June 19, 2019

Ontario City Council met in regular session on June 19, 2019, in the Municipal Building, with Council President Jim Hellinger presiding. The meeting opened at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present during roll call were Council members Larry Arnold, Eddie Gallo, Mark Weidemyre, Michele Webb, Nathan Sunderland, Council President Jim Hellinger, Law Director Andrew Medwid, Service-Safety Director Jeff Wilson and Clerk of Council Cathy VanAuker.

Mr. Sunderland moved to excuse Mr. Earhart and Mr. Zeiter from this evening's meeting, second by Mr. Arnold. Five members cast their votes Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed.

The minutes of the regular Council meeting of May 15, 2019 were presented for approval. Mr. Weidemyre moved to approve the minutes, second by Mrs. Webb. Five members cast their votes Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Mr. Weidemyre scheduled an Economic Development Committee meeting on June 19, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

Mr. Weidemyre said next week is the Select USA Investment Summit in Washington D.C. Mayor Hutchinson and Mr. Weidemyre are taking marketing brochures and thumb drives about the Ontario Commerce Park to distribute. Richland County Convention and Visitor's Bureau is shipping pamphlets to them that promote activities in the area.

Mrs. Webb moved to authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract and to approve the purchase order with LaBella for geotech testing of the concrete slab at the Ontario Commerce Park, second by Mr. Arnold. Five members cast their votes Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed.
