October 17, 2018

Ontario City Council met in regular session on October 17, 2018, in the Municipal Building, with Council President Jim Hellinger presiding. The meeting opened at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present during roll call were Council members Ken Earhart, Larry Arnold, Eddie Gallo, Mark Weidemyre, Michele Webb, Nathan Sunderland, Council President Jim Hellinger, Mayor Randy Hutchinson, Law Director Andrew Medwid, Service-Safety Director Jeff Wilson and Clerk of Council Cathy VanAuker.

Mr. Weidemyre moved to excuse Mr. Zeiter from the meeting, second by Mr. Arnold. Six members cast their votes Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed.

The minutes of the regular Council meeting of October 3, 2018 were presented for approval. Mrs. Webb moved to approve the minutes, second by Mr. Gallo. Six members cast their votes Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Mr. Gallo reported the Streets Committee discussed paving Lex-Springmill Road next year. Committee members approved the Service Safety Director to accept bids for the entire project to be completed in one year instead of two.

Mr. Weidemyre said the Economic Development Committee met to discuss options for the former GM property once the city takes ownership. The Mayor will research what can and can't be used to fill in the pits, running water and sewer lines to the Press Prep Building to make it marketable and ask an architect to design a layout consisting of 5 – 10 acre parcels.

- All of the power was disconnected so new lines would need installed.
- Mayor Hutchinson spoke with the high school government teacher, Mr. Coley, and he will have his students submit ideas for naming the property.

Mr. Sunderland moved to suspend the reading of Ordinance No. 18-40 on three separate days, second by Mr. Weidemyre. Six members cast their votes Aye, zero Nay, and the motion passed. Mr. Weidemyre read Ordinance No. 18-40 for the first time, by title only.

Mr. Weidemyre moved to adopt Ordinance No. 18-40, second by Mr. Earhart. Hearing no discussion, six members cast their votes Aye, zero Nay, and Ordinance No. 18-40 was adopted.
