Ontario City Council met in regular session on May 20, 2020, in the Municipal Building, with Council President Jim Hellinger presiding. Due to the coronavirus emergency declared by the Governor, the meeting was not open to the public but was accessible by Facebook Live. The meeting opened at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.
