Ontario City Council met in special session on December 22, 2020, in the Municipal Building, with Council President Eddie Gallo presiding. The meeting opened at 1:02 p.m.

Council members attended via teleconference. Present during roll call were Council members Ken Earhart, Dave Rehfeldt, Josh Bradley, Sherry Branham, Michele Webb, Nathan Sunderland and Council President Eddie Gallo. Also, in attendance was Mayor Randy Hutchinson, Law Director Andrew Medwid, Service-Safety Director Jeff Wilson and Clerk of Council Cathy VanAuker.

Mayor Hutchinson explained the legislation on the agenda was prepared due to the CARES Act funds the city received and the expenses related to COVID. Some of the purchases were Surface tablets for Council and webcams for employees to be able to participate in Zoom meetings and online training.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-39

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 20-08 KNOWN AS THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR 2020 BY MAKING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND.

Mr. Earhart moved to suspend the reading of Ordinance No. 20-39 on three separate days, second by Mr. Rehfeldt. Six members voted Aye by roll call, zero Nay, and the motion passed. Mr. Rehfeldt read Ordinance No. 20-39 for the first time, by title only.

Mr. Rehfeldt moved to adopt Ordinance No. 20-39, second by Ms. Branham. Hearing no discussion, six members voted Aye by roll call, zero Nay, and Ordinance No. 20-39 was adopted.

ORDINANCE NO. 20 – 40

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CITY OF ONTARIO CARES ACTS FUNDS FOR CITY EXPENDITURES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Mr. Sunderland moved to suspend the reading of Ordinance No. 20-40 on three separate days, second by Mr. Bradley. Six members voted Aye by roll call, zero Nay, and the motion passed. Mrs. Webb read Ordinance No. 20-40 for the first time, by title only.

Mrs. Webb moved to adopt Ordinance No. 20-40, second by Mr. Bradley. Hearing no discussion, six members voted Aye by roll call, zero Nay, and Ordinance No. 20-40 was adopted.

At 1:11 p.m., there being no further business to come before the meeting, the same was adjourned upon a motion by Mr. Earhart, second by Mr. Rehfeldt, and the motion passed.
