

The City of Ontario, in coordination with the Ohio Department of Transportation, is proposing to convert a two-way stop-controlled intersection into a single lane roundabout at Rock Road (CR 150) and W. 4th Street (CR 501). Improvements include construction of new asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, median islands, storm sewer, street lighting and traffic control. Construction is currently scheduled to begin in April 2029 and will last about 7 months.

A small amount of temporary and permanent right-of-way may be required from properties adjacent to the project area. If right-of-way acquisition is needed from your property, a real estate representative will reach out to you individually in mid-2026.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by ODOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 14, 2020, and executed by FHWA and ODOT, and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 3, 2024, and executed by FRA and ODOT.
